

No. F.W./Election-2017/ Whereas, the Governor of Haryana is satisfied that the exemption is required to enable the adult workers, who are enrolled as voters in the State of Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand employed in the factories situated in the State of Haryana to exercise their franchise in the ensuing General Election to be held on 11th, 15th, 19th, 23rd, 27th, February, 4th and 8th March, 2017.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act 63 of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to exempt only those workers who are enrolled as voters in the state of Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand employed in the factories situated in the State of Haryana from the operations of provision of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act for the week commencing from 09.02.2017 and ending on 15.02.2017, for the week commencing from 23.02.2017 and ending on 01.03.2017, for the week commencing from 02.03.2017 and ending on 8.3.2017, subject to the condition that no adult worker who is voter enrolled in the State Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand shall be required or allowed to work on 11.02.2017 (Saturday), 15.02.2017 (Wednesday), 23.02.2017 (Thursday), 27.02.2017 (Monday), 04.03.2017 (Saturday) and 08.03.2017 (Wednesday) in the factories situated in the state of Haryana.
