

## Office Order

**Subject: - Disposal of the applications for registration & licensing/renewal/ amendment under various Labour Laws within prescribed timeline.**

As it is matter of record that State Government has made it mandatory vide notification No. 6/37/2017/-1Lab dated 24<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to grant registration & licensing/renewal/ amendment under various Labour Laws, as mentioned in the notification itself, only through e-services of the Labour Department, Haryana at website [www.hrylabour.gov.in](http://www.hrylabour.gov.in).

One of the action points of the Business Reform Action Plan 2017/ Ease of Doing Business has further mandated to display a dashboard in the public domain at URL <https://hrylabour.gov.in/reports> about the disposal status of these online applications. This dashboard categorically informs the public at large as to whether the online applications were disposed well within prescribed timeline or not. The timeline of various e-services is also available on the website at URL <https://hrylabour.gov.in/content/rts>. This issue of non-disposal of applications within prescribed timeline is being reviewed by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana in scheduled review meeting on 13.07.2017.

In view of the above you are hereby directed to dispose the applications in the Branches/jurisdiction under your control immediately well within prescribed timelines and to keeping doing so in future as well.
