Subject:- Celebration of "Constitution Day" on 26th November, 2017.


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that the Government of India had decided to celebrate "Constitution Day" every year on 26th November. On this day, the people of India adopted, enacted and gave to themselves the Constitution of India in the constituent Assembly on the 26th day of November, 1949. Accordingly, **"Constitution Day" may be celebrated on 26th November, 2017** in a befitting manner, by organising various activities, some of which are as under :-

- (a) Reading out the Preamble to Constitution (as it exists today) in all Educational Institutions and Government offices.
- (b) Mock Parliament may be organized. (in Higher Education institutions like Schools/Colleges/ Law Colleges/Universities (at least one per district).
- (c) Essay writing/debate competitions and lectures may be organized in Schools/ Colleges/ Universities.

The Departments & Districts may identify more activities to celebrate Constitution Day this year in order to create awareness among people about the Constitution of India.
