2. In keeping with the practice in the past nine years, it is requested that schools and Educational Institutions in your state may be instructed to organize National Voters' Day for infusion of democratic values like debate, declamations, mock polls, drawing and quiz competitions on or during run-up to National Voters' Day with the themes of democracy and electoral participations.
