No. FW/Election,2022/3301 -Whereas the Bye-Election, 2022 to 21-Sardarshahar AC, District Churu of Rajasthan for which poll shall be held on the 05.12.2022(Monday) as per letter of the Chief Electoral Officer, Haryana issued vide No. 130/Paid Holiday/RJ, Bye-Elec-22/2AE-5343 dated 18.11.2022.

And whereas, it has been considered necessary to provide opportunity to the public to exercise their franchise.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act 63 of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to exempt all the adult workers working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana who are the voters in aforesaid Bye-Election to 21-Sardarshahar AC, District Churu of Rajasthan for which poll shall be held on the 05.12.2022(Monday) from the operations of provisions of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act, for the week commencing from 04.12.2022 and ending 10.12.2022, subject to the condition that no adult worker who is enrolled as voter in Bye-Election to 21-Sardarshahar AC, District Churu of Rajasthan shall be required or allowed to work on 05.12.2022 (Monday) in the factories of the state of Haryana.
