No.Elec-2022/FW/407 Whereas, the Governor of Haryana is satisfied that the exemption is required to enable the adult workers, working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana to exercise their franchise in the General Election to Uttar Pradesh-2022 and Punjab-2022 as per the schedule announced by the Election Commission of India.

And whereas, it has been considered necessary to provide opportunity to the public to exercise their franchise.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act 63 of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to exempt all the adult workers working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana who are the voters of the State as mentioned below in the table and are entitled to vote at an election to the Legislative Assembly of Uttar Pradesh and Punjab, on the day of polling of respective State from the operations of provision of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act for the weeks as mentioned in the below table subject to the condition that no adult worker who is enrolled as the voters of that respective States shall be required or allowed to work on the polling day of respective State, in the State of Haryana.
